

Guidelines for submitting abstracts
to the 14th International Coating Science and Technology Symposium,
September 7-10, 2008 in Marina del Rey, California

For each conference presentation, an abstract is required that summarizes the presentation. The paper submission process has several steps: (1) submission of an abstract, by March 1, 2008; (2) notification of abstract acceptance, by May 1, 2008; and (3) submission of extended abstract, by July 1, 2008. Abstract and extended abstract will be accepted only in PDF form. Here are the instructions for submitting abstracts.

Abstracts should be no more than 150-200 words in length. The abstract must contain (1) the presentation title; (2) name of the presenting author; (3) contact information for the corresponding author, including affiliation, e-mail address and telephone number; and (4) type of presentation (poster or oral) preferred. This template for the preparation of the abstract in Microsoft Word format may be found on the ISCST website (www.iscst.org).

The abstract is to be prepared using the following format:

- Double space abstract.
- Page Setup for 8 ½" x 11" Letter with Portrait Orientation.
- Use 1" margins.
- For Microsoft Word, use Times New Roman with font size between 10 pt. and 12 pt.
- Do not include figures.

Margins on this word template are designed to accommodate the ISCST2008 Proceedings Layout. Please DO NOT use other layouts.

All submissions should be submitted electronically in PDF format through the ISCST web site : <http://www.iscst.org/>. If you have queries please email the Symposium Chair F. Miguel Joos (joos@alum.mit.edu).

Submitting an abstract implies that the presenting author has sufficient funds for travel and conference expenses.
